### **Day 11 Khajuraho - Delhi**

Depart Khajurho by IC 405 at 1400 hrs

### **Day 12 Delhi - Agra**

Today morning after breakfast start your drive to Agra. Upon arrival you will be met and assisted in checking in at your hotel.

Agra is renowned the world over due to the fabulous Taj Mahal and is situated on the right bank of the river Yamuna. Agra is a city with a glorious past and has the distinction of being the capital of various ruling dynasties.

Today afternoon get ready to visit the Seventh Wonder of the World at Agra. The Taj Mahal was built by Shahjahan as a memorial to his wife Mumtaz Mahal by the banks of river Yamuna. After her untimely death, Shahjahan buried her mortal remains in this mausoleum. And after his own demise he was placed to rest next to his beloved queen in the same mausoleum. The Taj Mahal is an extravagant monument built in love. The great monument was completed in 1653. Around 20,000 workers from all over the country and central Asia were recruited to translate

Later today visit the Agra Fort - begun by Emperor Akbar in 1565. The high red stone monument stretches for around one and a half miles. The palace is a notable for its smooth blending of Hindu and central Asian architectural styles. See the Diwan-i-Am (hall of public audiences), Diwan-i-Khas (hall of private audiences), the Khas Palace, the Sheesh Mahal (palace of mirrors), the Shah Jahani Mahal (Shahjahan's Palace), Jahangiri Mahal (Jahangir's Palace) and the Akbari Mahal (Akbar's palace) inside the fort.

### **Day 13 Agra – Ranthambore**

Today morning after breakfast start your drive to Ranthambore enroute visiting Fatehpur Sikri. Situated around 24 miles from Agra, This amazing palace was built by the Mughal Emperor Akbar but had to be abandoned after just 15 years due to scarcity of potable water.

After the visit you will be transferred to Bharatpur to board your train to Sawai Madhopur.

### **Day 14 Ranthambore**

Ranthambore National Park, which is one of the finest tiger reserves in the country Park's abandoned fortress, lakes and above all its 'friendly' tigers have made it one of the most filmed wildlife reserves in the world. Ranthambore was declared a wildlife sanctuary in 1955 and became part of Project Tiger in 1973. This wildlife sanctuary is considered to be the country's best for observing and photographing the activities of the tiger. The park, covering an area of 392 sq.kms is home to more than 300 species of birds. The tiger, hyena, ratel, jackal and fox are among those constituting the carnivorous population here. Sawai Madhopur is known for its exclusive toys, ethnic ornaments and costumes.
